Terms and Conditions – cTrader WebView Plugin Online Hackathon

These Terms and Conditions (the "**Terms**") govern participation in the cTrader WebView Plugin Online Hackathon (the "**Hackathon**"), organized and administered by Spotware Systems Ltd, a company incorporated in the Republic of Cyprus with registration number HE 265059 and registered address at 78 Spyrou Kyprianou, Magnum House, 3rd Floor, 3076 Limassol, Cyprus ("**Spotware**").

By participating in the Hackathon, each participant ("**Participant**") acknowledges, accepts, and agrees to be bound by these Terms in their entirety. Non-compliance with any provision herein may result in disqualification.

1. Objective

The purpose of the Hackathon is to encourage innovation, adoption, and visibility of the WebView Plugin functionality within the cTrader ecosystem through the development and submission of original plugins.

2. Eligibility

2.1. The Hackathon is open to individual developers, coders, traders, and employees of Spotware Systems Ltd and/or users of the cTrader platform, regardless of geographical location.

2.2. Participants must be of legal age in their country of residence and must have the legal capacity to enter into binding agreements.

2.3. Participation is void where prohibited by applicable law.

3. Hackathon Period

3.1. The Hackathon is scheduled to commence on 16 July 2025 and conclude on 8 September 2025(the "Hackathon Period").

3.2. Spotware reserves the right to modify the Hackathon Period at its sole discretion and will communicate any such changes via official channels.

3.3. All entries must be fully completed, submitted, and registered by 23:59 EET on 31 August 2025.

4. Participation Requirements

To enter the Hackathon, Participants must complete the following steps:

4.1 Join the official Developer Club.

4.2 Visit https://go.spotware.com/webview-hackathon for documentation, resources, and guidance.

4.3 Develop an original WebView Plugin, either manually or with the aid of AI-based tools.

4.4 Publish the Plugin via the cTrader Store in the WebView section, following the prescribed procedures.

4.5 Register the submission by messaging the Telegram bot @ctrader_suggestions_bot with the phrase "WebView Plugin Contest" and complete the subsequent registration steps.

5. Evaluation and Winner Selection

5.1. All eligible entries will be reviewed by the cTrader Management team.

5.2. Evaluation criteria include, but are not limited to: originality, functionality, usability, and popularity within the cTrader Store.

5.3. Spotware will select and publicly announce three (3) winners by 8 September 2025.

6. Prizes

6.1. The prizes awarded shall be as follows:

- First Place: Apple MacBook Pro
- Second Place: Apple iPad Pro
- Third Place: Apple Watch Series 10

6.2. Spotware reserves the right to substitute any prize with another of equivalent value at its sole discretion, with or without prior notice.

6.3. All taxes, duties, and other charges associated with the receipt or use of the prize shall be borne solely by the respective winner. Spotware shall not be liable for any such costs.

7. Intellectual Property and Licensing

7.1. By participating in the Hackathon, Participants agree to the cTrader Store Terms of Use and Privacy Policy, available at https://ctrader.com/terms-of-use and https://ctrader.com/privacy-policy, respectively.

7.2. Participants retain all intellectual property rights in and to their submitted plugins.

7.3. Notwithstanding the foregoing, by submitting a plugin, Participants grant Spotware a worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free, irrevocable license to use, reproduce, publicly display,

distribute, and promote the plugin in connection with the Hackathon and any related promotional or marketing activities.

8. Disqualification

Spotware reserves the right to disqualify any Participant or submission that:

8.1. Violates any of these Terms;

8.2. Fails to meet the technical or quality standards of the cTrader Store moderation process;

8.3. Infringes the intellectual property or other rights of any third party;

8.4. Involves fraudulent, unlawful, or unethical behavior.

9. Liability and Indemnity

Participants assume all risks associated with their participation. To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, Participants agree to release, indemnify, and hold harmless Spotware, its officers, employees, and affiliates from and against any claims, liabilities, losses, damages, or expenses arising from or related to participation in the Hackathon or acceptance or use of any prize.

10. Modifications and Termination

Spotware reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, suspend, or modify the Hackathon or these Terms at any time for any reason, including but not limited to technical, operational, or legal requirements, without incurring any liability to Participants.

11. Data Protection

All personal data collected in connection with the Hackathon will be processed in accordance with Spotware's Privacy Policy and applicable data protection legislation, including the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), where applicable.

12. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

These Terms shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of Cyprus. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with the Hackathon shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Cyprus.
